The Commonwealth War Graves Commission (CWGC) cares for the graves and memorials of 1.7 million Commonwealth servicemen and women who died in the two world wars, at 23,000 sites in more than 150 countries.

Established in 1917 while the First World War still raged, the founding principle of commemorating each person equally, irrespective of rank, religious beliefs or nationality, still ensures that their names will never be forgotten.

Staged in the Grade-I-listed Canada Building at the largest CWGC site in the UK, For Then, For Now, Forever uses historic artefacts and archival materials to take you on a journey through the compelling story of this unique organisation.
