Friday Evening Meal

The formal Reunion Dinner will be served in the Dining Room at 8.00pm. A Seating Plan will be located near the entrance which will show your table number. At each table in the Dining Room place cards with names and menu selections will indicate seating positions.

Towards the end of the meal we will be showing short extracts of video footage taken at the dedication of the Memorial Stone in 1982. It is also twenty years since the inaugural meeting of the Association at the RAF Museum, Hendon in June 1992 and to celebrate these two significant anniversaries there is a small memento for each guest at their table.

There will be also be a short address by Wilfred Burie from Rebecq and the return of various parts from Lancaster BQ-H (JA712) which crashed in the village on 28th May 1944.
